

Call to Order:

Mayor Turner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Roll Call:

Roll call was answered by Councilman Blankenship, Councilman Dinn, Councilman Herald, Councilman Martin and Councilwoman Wilson.

Approval of Minutes:

Upon motion of Councilman Blankenship, seconded by, Councilman Martin to approve the Minutes of December 12, 2011, Regular Meeting. Mayor Turner called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor's Comments:

Mayor Turner presented Resolution No. 12-0101: Appointing Eric Muench as a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission and establishing the term of office for the member.

Chief Rouse thanked Doug & Sheila Bray for their donation and advised that a Shot Gun and Rifle were purchased with the funds.

City Administrator Comments:

Mr. Vance stated that they would be complying with KEMI Auditors suggestions such as monthly safety meetings with Public Works, city safety committee with quarterly meetings and
