February 6, 2012

The regular meeting of the Wilder City Council was held on Monday, February 6, 2012 at the Wilder City Building, 520 Licking Pike, Wilder, Kentucky 41071.

Call to Order:

Mayor Turner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Roll Call:

Roll call was answered by Councilman Blankenship, Councilman Dinn, Councilwoman Gearding, Councilman Herald, Councilman Martin and Councilwoman Wilson

Approval of Minutes:

Upon motion of Councilman Blankenship seconded by Councilwoman Wilson to approve the Minutes of January 16, 2012, Regular Meeting. Mayor Turner called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

Attorney's Report:

Attorney Verst presented Ordinance No. 12-0201: Approving a Lease Agreement with Republic Bank & Trust Company for the refinancing of the city building in a maximum principal amount not to exceed \$1,300,000.00; providing for the payment and security of the lease and deposits to a sinking fund; authorizing the execution of various documents related to such lease; and making certain designations regarding such lease. [First Reading].

Councilman Blankenship questioned what a sinking fund was.

Mr. Kofflar stated that it was an account in General Fund used to appropriate the debt service which is similar to an escrow account.

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Councilman Martin asked what the interest rate would be.

Mr. Vance advised that the new rate will be 2.19% for the first five years and a variable rate for the next five years without a prepayment penalty.

Discussion ensued regarding the refinancing and the savings the city will have with the refinance.

Upon motion of Councilman Blankenship seconded by Councilman Martin to approve ordinance No.12-0201: Approving a lease agreement with Republic Bank & Trust Company for the refinancing of the city building in a maximum principal amount not to exceed \$1,300,000.00; providing for the payment and security of the lease and deposits to a sinking fund; authorizing the execution of various documents related to such lease; and making certain designations regarding such lease. Upon motion of Councilman Herald seconded by Councilwoman Wilson to accept the bids of \$10,001.00 for the 1996 GMC Dump truck and \$7,900.00 for the 2001 Ford F250 Pickup. Mayor Turner called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Turner advised that representatives from Republic Services were present to answer any questions regarding the city waste collection.

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Mr. Brad Brian advised that a 95 gallon trash can and a 65 gallon can for recycling are available to the residents at no additional charge. Residents may contact them at 513-771-4200 to have one delivered to them.
