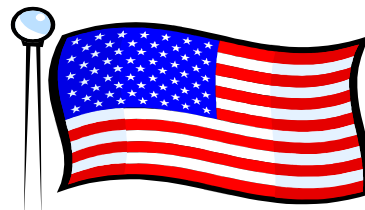

February is Earthquake Awareness Month



The Wilder Fire Department, in conjunction with the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management, would like to remind our citizens that February is Earthquake Awareness Month. Although a strong earthquake hasn't struck this area in well over one hundred years we will still like you to stay vigilant in case one should strike. The following tips are provided for you to stay safe.

When in a HIGH-RISE BUILDING, move against an interior wall if you are not near a desk or table. Protect your head and neck with your arms. Do not use the elevators.

When OUTDOORS, move to a clear area away from trees, signs, buildings, or downed electrical wires and poles.

When on a SIDEWALK NEAR BUILDINGS, duck into a doorway to protect yourself from falling bricks, glass, plaster and other debris.

When DRIVING, pull over to the side of the road and stop. Avoid overpasses and power lines. Stay inside your vehicle until the shaking stops.

We thank everyone for supporting us and the fireman and we are looking forward to seeing you Friday, February 19th, our first fish fry and the start of lent.

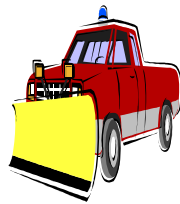
We are very saddened at the loss of our member Mathilda Turner. She was a great supporter of the Ladies Auxiliary.

SNOW & ICE REMOVAL



REMINDERS:

PARK CARS IN DRIVEWAY DURING AND/OR AT SNOW AND ICE STORM ADVISORY. This allows streets to be completely cleared and also helps keep the plow from piling snow around parked cars.

CUL-DE-SAC— Do not park in the cul-de-sac during inclement weather. The truck with the snowplow cannot make turns when cars are parked in the cul-de-sac. Please conform.

PROCEDURE FOR SNOW REMOVAL:

The hilly areas are the first streets to be cleared. We then proceed to clear the level areas. Please note that Three Mile Road, Moock Road, Licking Pike, and Johns Hill Road are state roads and are not maintained by the City of Wilder.
