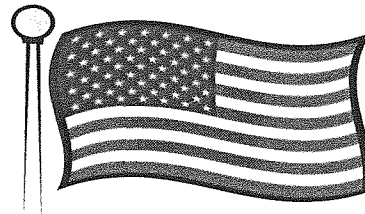

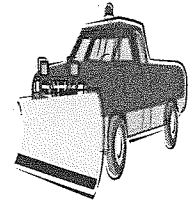
We thank everyone for supporting us and the fire department. we are looking forward to seeing you Friday, February 24th, at our first fish fry and the start of lent.

SNOW & ICE REMOVAL



REMINDERS:

PARK CARS IN DRIVEWAY DURING AND/OR AT SNOW AND ICE STORM ADVISORY. This allows streets to be completely cleared and also helps keep the plow from piling snow around parked cars.

CUL-DE-SAC- Do not park in the cul-de-sac during inclement weather. The truck with the snowplow cannot make turns when cars are parked in the cul-de-sac. Please conform.

PROCEDURE FOR SNOW REMOVAL:

The hilly areas are the first streets to be cleared. We then proceed to clear the level areas. Please note that Three Mile Road, Mooch Road, Licking Pike, and Johns Hill Road are state roads and are not maintained by the City of Wilder. If you have a problem or questions regarding these roads, please call the Kentucky Department of Transportation at 341-2700.

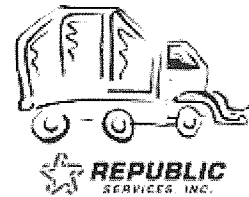
Republic Services is excited to partner with the City of Wilder on their Solid Waste Collection.

This includes the removal of your waste and recycling every Tuesday. We have the same contract with the city as the previous contractor. The same truck will be servicing your waste and recycling needs. This is a split body truck that holds these items separately. In addition, if you would like a 65-gallon recycling cart instead of a recycling bin, please contact our customer service department. We also offer a 90-gallon container that you can receive for your solid waste both at no additional cost to Wilder residents.

If you would like a larger recycling cart or wheeled waste container please call the customer service department. Our customer services representatives are standing by to assist you with any questions. Below is a list of the items that can be recycled. Once again if you have any questions please call us at (513) 771-4200.

RECYCLING MATERIALS ACCEPTED:

- Aluminum Cans, Trays & Foil (*trays & foil must be cleaned*)
- Steel Cans & Tins
- Aseptic Packaging & Gable Top Containers (*milk & juice cartons*)
- Glass Bottles and Jars - (*clear, brown, green No window glass, dinnerware or ceramics*)
- All Plastics #1 - #7.
- Plastic Buckets, such as kitty litter containers (*5 gallon size maximum No metal handles*)
- Newspaper, including inserts (*remove plastic sleeves*)
- Cardboard (no waxed cardboard) all cardboard boxes must be broken down into 2'x2' pieces or smaller.
Larger boxes, if not broken down, will not be recycled.
- Kraft (brown paper) bags
- Magazines, Catalogs, and telephone Books
- Office, Computer, Notebook & Gift Wrap Paper (no metal clips)
- Chipboard (cereal, cake & food mix boxes, shoe boxes)
- Junk mail & envelopes
- Paperback Books (no hard cover books)

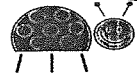

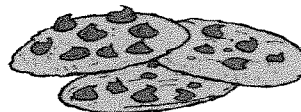
