CHANGES TO ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCES

On August 5th, the Wilder City Council passed at first reading some revisions to the city's animal control ordinances. Among some of the most notable changes are increases in penalties for violation of leash laws, habitual barking, animal welfare and other areas pertaining to animals. The changes actually doubled the penalty from a class A misdemeanor and up to \$250 fine to now, any violation of any of the animal control laws in the city would be class B misdemeanor punishable by a \$250 fine or more as well as possible jail time.

The leash law section has undergone the most revision with sections added regarding vicious dogs. New areas include financial responsibility (insurance requirements) of owners with dangerous or vicious dogs, postings of "Beware of Dog" signs and the overall penalties for dogs that are off leash and do damage to people, other animals or property.

In short, everyone is encouraged to check out the changes in the ordinance and in general, continue to be responsible pet owners. The second reading and expected passage of the proposed changes will be at the September 3rd council meeting. If anyone has any questions or wishes to view the proposed changes they should contact the administrative offices at the Wilder City Building 581-8884.
