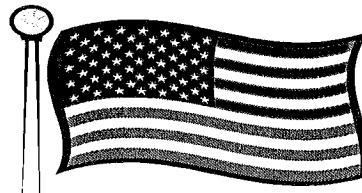

BARKING DOGS

Just a reminder the City of Wilder has ordinances pertaining to animals specifically with regard to the following issues:

A Leash Law, meaning dogs are not permitted to run at large. They must be on a leash if they are off of the property where they are normally kept.

Habitual barking. No person shall harbor, keep, or permit a dog owned by him or which is under his control, which by loud and frequent or habitual barking, howling or barking, caused annoyance or disturbance to other person or persons living or having a right to be in the vicinity.

Removal of excrement. Please be responsible and clean up after your pet. The city is planning to install more waste stations along sidewalks and parks in the city.

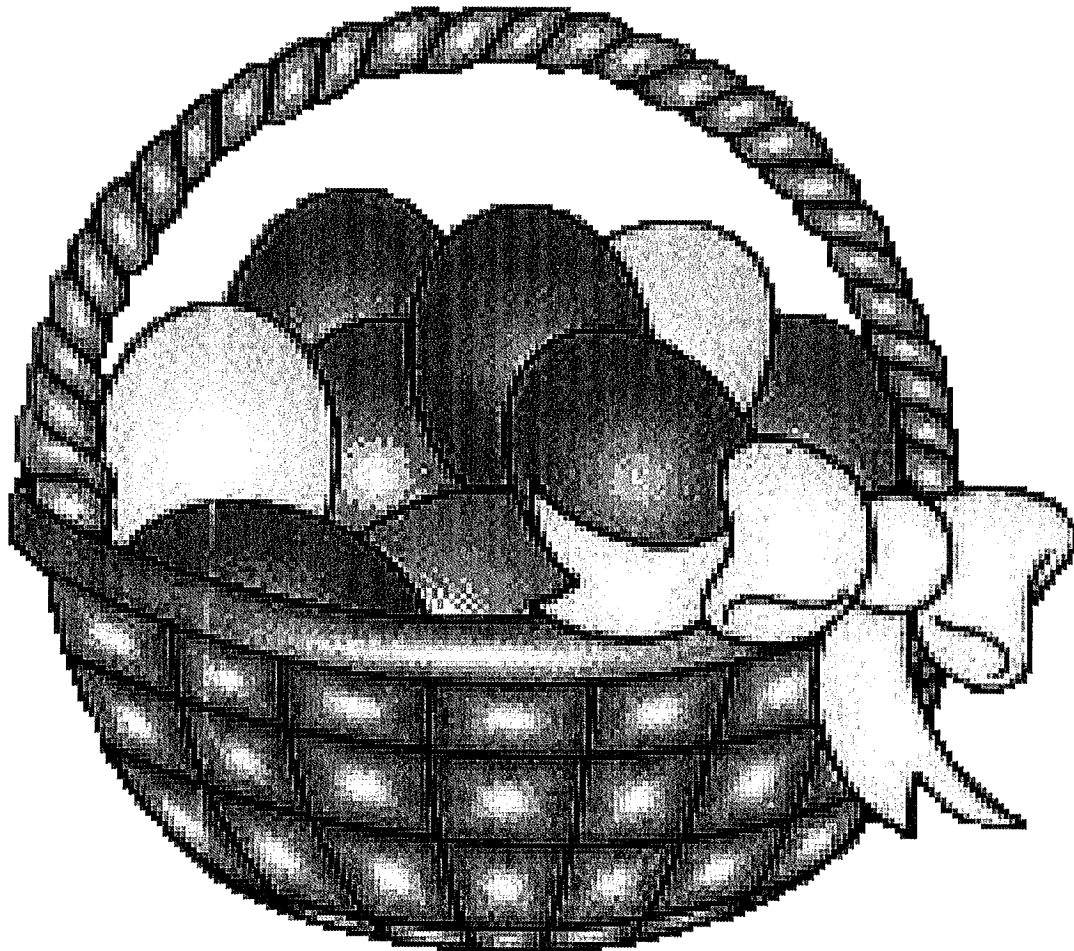

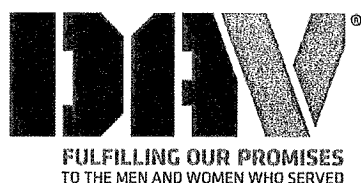
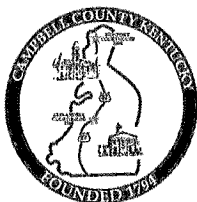
