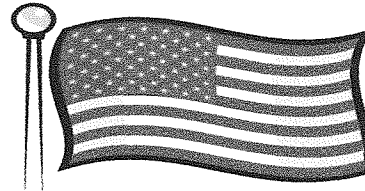

ORDINANCE NO. 12-0301

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING TEXT FOR THE CITY OF WILDER TOWN CENTER (TC) ZONE TO PERMIT INDOOR ATHLETIC FACILITIES, REMOVE SPECIALTY STORES AND TO REVISE VIDEO TAPE RENTAL THE GENERAL COMMERCIAL (GC) ZONE TO PERMIT PAWN SHOPS AND THE HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL (HC) ZONE TO PERMIT THE SALE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS WITH CONDITIONS AND REPEALING CHAPTER 112 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHITE GOODS DISPOSAL

The Wilder Maintenance Department will be picking up white goods such as Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, etc., which contain freon and cannot be picked up with your regular waste collection service on May 21st. If you choose to have the item picked up by Republic you must have the freon removed and the item must have a tag stating it has been removed properly.

Any other large item can be picked up with your regular waste collection. If you do have a large item for pick-up, please contact Republic at 513-771-4200 so that they can have two people on the truck for that pick-up.

If you have a white goods item that contains freon, you must contact the city building (581-8884) by May 18th @ 3:00 p.m., to advise of the item and to be placed on the pick-up list between 8:00 AM & 3:00 PM.

This needs to be done so that the Maintenance Department can make proper arrangements.
