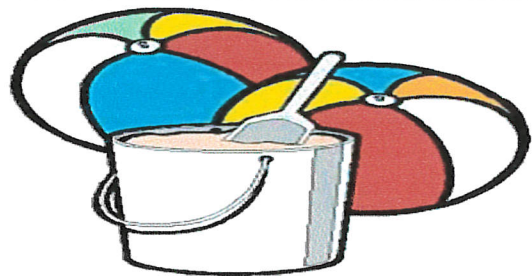

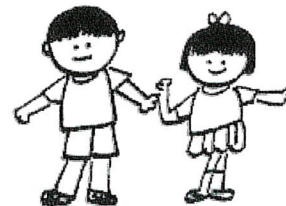

Wilder Recreation Summer Program

When: From June 6, 2016 to July 22, 2016

Who: This program is available for Wilder residents from the ages of 7 – 15. All children participating in the program must be registered with the Recreation Department. For children not living in the city of Wilder and planning to participate, there is a non-refundable \$50.00 charge.

How: Registration forms are available at the information desk at the Wilder City Building or on the City Website.

Activities: The summer recreation program includes field trips to various locations. Other activities available are video games, arts and crafts, field games, water games, music, board games and sign language lessons. Children may want to check the schedule for Extended Camp Days, which is replacing Camp Night this year. There may be changes or additions to the summer camp schedule, so check weekly at the Recreation Center.

Staff: The staff this year consists of Bill Turner, Angelic Boyers, and Sharon Beatsch. All are either current or retired teachers.

We hope you have a safe and happy summer!

NOTE TO PARENTS:

The program is not a day care center. Children are supervised while at the Center but they are free to come and go as they please. If you have children attending, let them know your rules. Also note that children must sign in and out and are responsible for keeping all facilities clean.

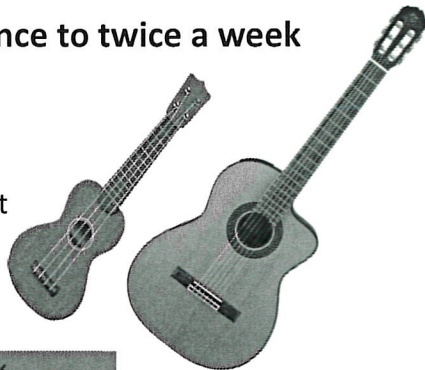
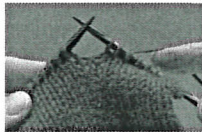
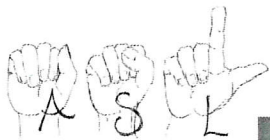
