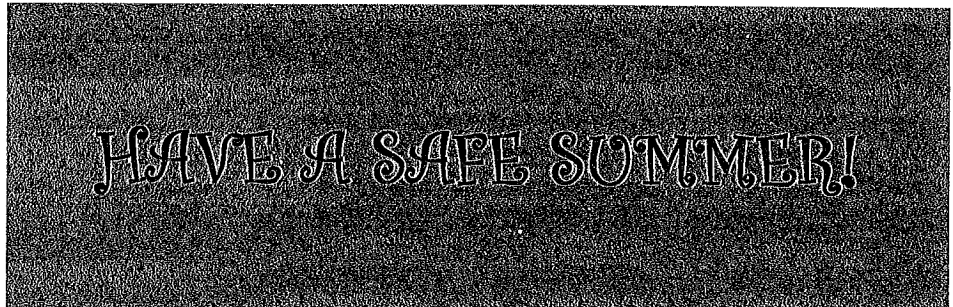
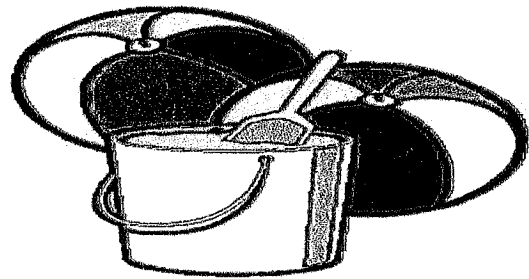

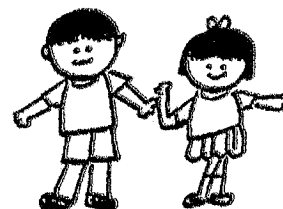

## Theft Prevention and Advice

To help keep our city as safe as possible, we want to remind all residents that this is the time of year for the burglars and thieves to be roaming the neighborhoods, looking for easy targets. Something as simple as leaving your garage door open for an extended length of time provides them with a very tempting and actually, quite easy mark for thefts to occur.

We encourage residents to stay vigilant and always keep your homes and vehicles secure and report anything suspicious to police. Day time burglaries are surprisingly common, however, most people associate them with night. In the day, it is easy to overlook suspicious activity and thieves know this as well. Generally, they will knock on a door and once they are sure the resident is not at home, they will break in. It may only take two or three minutes to gather numerous valuable items and they're gone.

We would be happy to provide suggestions to anyone who may have security concerns. Please understand, we must work together to keep Wilder safe. Also, check our Facebook page for updates and other important information. When calling, understand, we are not always in the office to answer. ## Wilder Recreation Summer Program

**When:** From June 4, 2018 to July 20, 2018

**Who:** This program is available for Wilder residents from the ages of 7 – 15. All children participating in the program must be registered with the Recreation Department.

**How:** Registration forms are available at the information desk at the Wilder City Building or on the City Website.

**Activities:** The summer recreation program includes field trips to various locations. Other activities available are video games, arts and crafts, field games, water games, music, and board games. Lessons available include: crochet, guitar, ukulele and sign language. Children may want to check the schedule for Extended Camp Days that happened periodically throughout the summer. There may be changes or additions to the summer camp schedule, so check weekly at the Recreation Center.

**Staff:** The staff this year consists of Bill Turner, Angelic Boyers, and Sharon Beatsch. All are either current or retired teachers.

We hope you have a safe and happy summer!

### **NOTE TO PARENTS:**

The program is not a day care center. Children are supervised while at the Center but they are free to come and go as they please. If you have children attending, let them know your rules. Also note that children must sign in and out and are responsible for keeping all facilities clean.
