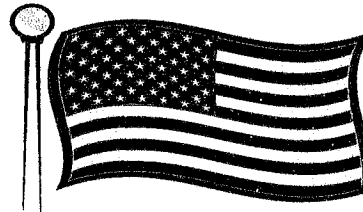

PRESCRIPTION DRUG DISPOSAL

The Wilder Police Department now has a prescription drug drop box located in the lobby of the City Building. This secure drop box is available to the public to dispose of any medicine that is no longer needed or outdated.

These drugs can be targeted for theft or misuse, often times by people that have access to your residence. Placing them in the trash or disposing of them through the sewer system is also not recommended and can pose other problems.

Items that are NOT accepted are needles, liquids, inhalers, aerosol cans, thermometers, and medications from businesses or clinics.

The Northern Kentucky Drug Strike Force empties the drop box and disposes of the contents safely.

CHILD I.D. CARDS

The Wilder Police Department now has a new Child I.D. card system that will allow us to create identification cards for children. These cards are the size of a credit card and include a color photo of your child, your child's information, and digitally scanned thumb print.
