

**CITY OF WILDER, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 25-0801**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 51 SECTION
51.03 OF THE WILDER MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDING
THE DAY OF THE WEEK FOR SOLID
WASTE/RECYCLING COLLECTION.**

WHEREAS, the City of Wilder has previously adopted a Solid Waste Ordinance No. 92-1201, January 1993; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance was codified in the city code under Chapter 51; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 51, Section 51.03 (A) states the day of the week collection is Tuesday and the current solid waste contractor for the city Bestway has requested a change of day collection to a day mutually agreed upon between the city and the contractor as set forth in the contract.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WILDER, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION ONE

§ 51.03 COLLECTION DAYS.

(A) Regularly scheduled days for the collection of solid waste and recycling from residential and commercial units will be at a day mutually agreed upon between the city and the contractor as set forth in the contract. ~~is Tuesday of each week with the exception of~~ With the exception of two

(2) holidays: Christmas Day and New Year's Day where ~~c~~Collection is normally made on the following day, in accordance with an agreed schedule between the collector and the city.

(B) Curbside collections shall only be made between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. anywhere throughout the city. Enforcement of collection times will be administered by the Wilder Police Department. Violations of these times shall be deemed a violation of this chapter and/or subject to a \$100.00 fine per incident as described in the contract documents.

(C) All missed collections shall be reported to the city at the earliest possible time. The collector will then be informed by telephone, email or facsimile of the missed collections. The collector shall pick up all misses within twenty-four (24) hours after notification. Failure to collect missed pick-ups within twenty-four (24) hours shall be deemed a violation of the contract and subject to a \$100.00 fine per incident as described in the contract documents.


SECTION TWO

That this Ordinance be read on two separate occasions, shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer published in accordance with law and made a part of the

records of the City of Wilder. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
