

**CITY OF WILDER, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 26-0603**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT
POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL BY ADDING POLICY
#61 LICENSE PLATE READERS PER THE RECOMMENDED
MODEL POLICY PROPOSED BY THE KENTUCKY LEAGUE
OF CITIES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Wilder Police Department has a policy and procedures manual for all police officers employed by the City of Wilder to follow; and,

WHEREAS, the City with the recent installation and use of Flock License Plate Readers, finds it necessary at this time to amend said policy and procedures manual to include the model Kentucky League of Cities policy relating to License Plate Readers (LPR) based on recommendations from state statutes and the Kentucky League of Cities (KLC), the city's insurance provider; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky League of Cities (KLC) provided the accompanying model policy for consideration and inclusion within the police policy manual and to stay in compliance with KLC's ongoing audits of policy and the department.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF WILDER, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION ONE

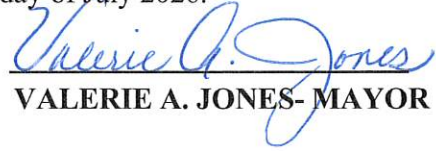
That the policy and procedures manual be amended as set forth in the attached License Plate Readers policy as recommended by the Kentucky League of Cities (KLC). A copy of said policy change is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance. Said changes once adopted to be included in the police policy and procedures manual for use by the Wilder Police Department.

SECTION TWO

That this Ordinance be read on two separate occasions, shall be signed by the mayor, attested by the City Clerk published in accordance with law and made a part of the records of the City of Wilder. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
